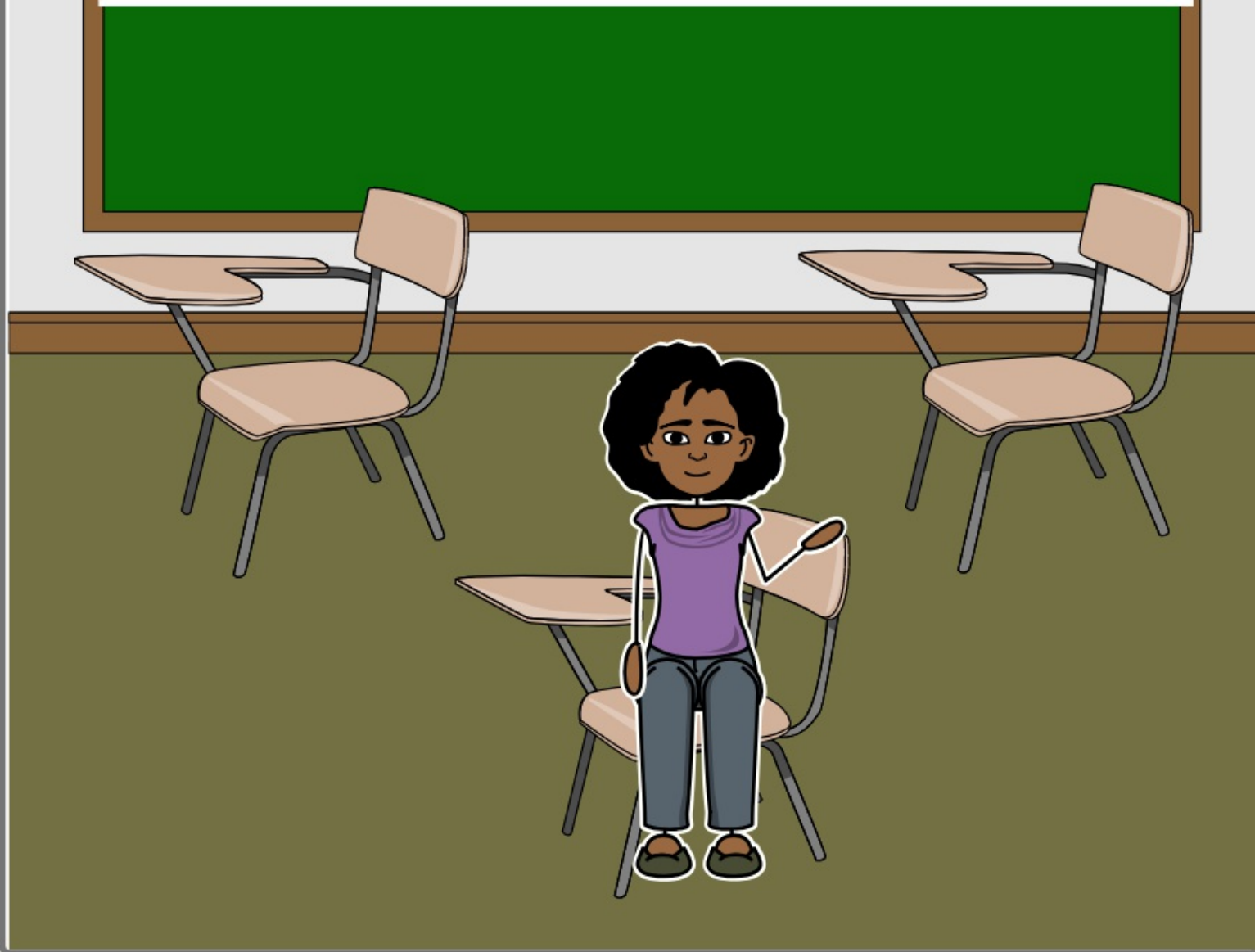




This story takes place at a university. Through the experiences of Adaze, the story will share the challenges that immigrants face in and out of the classroom at universities.

Adaze goes to a party with her friend Marianna, from her home country. But, she can't help but feeling like her friend is acting more American than Nigerian.



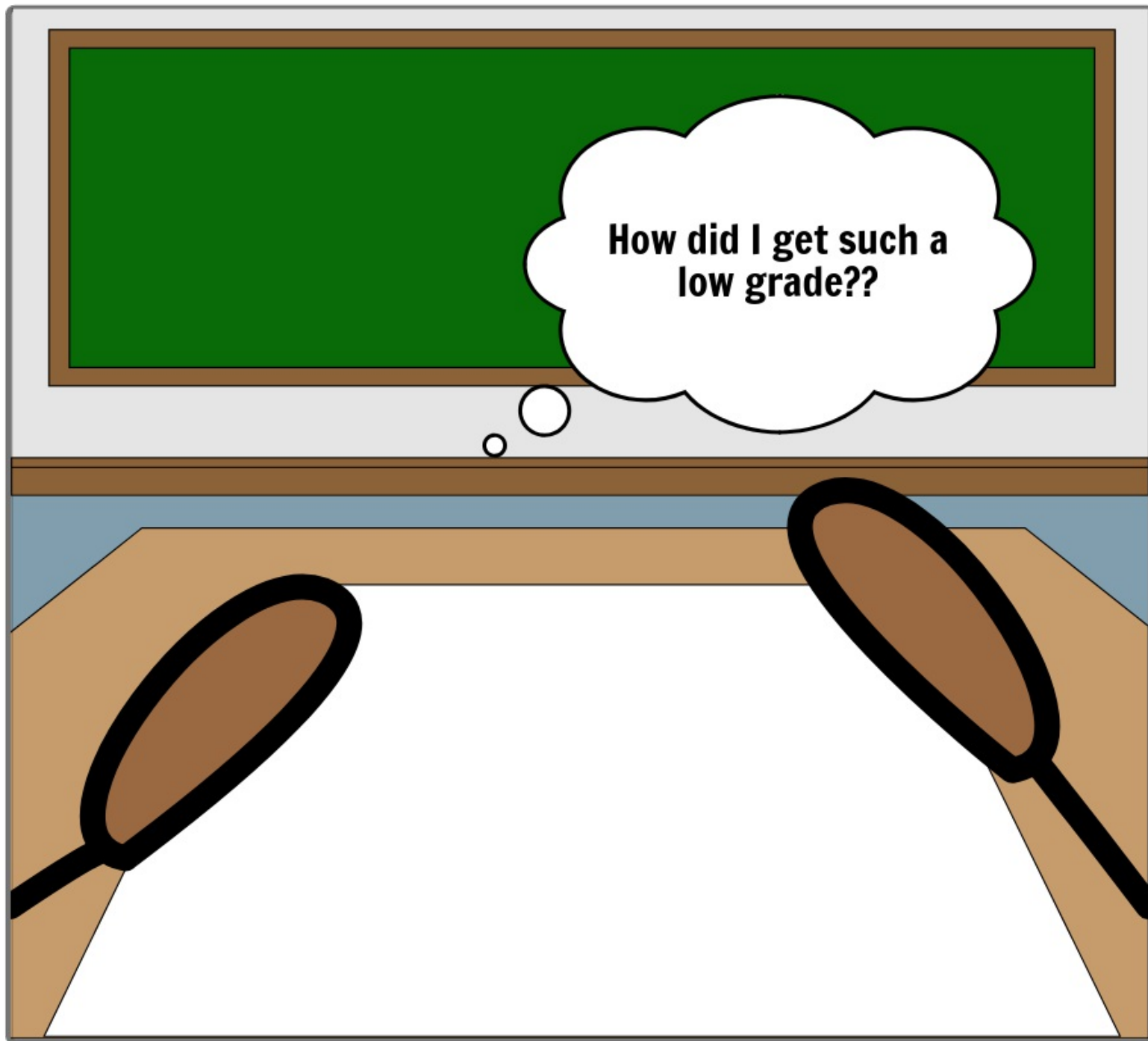
Adaze Leaves the party to go back to her room to reflect her feelings about not feeling like she doesn't belongs here.

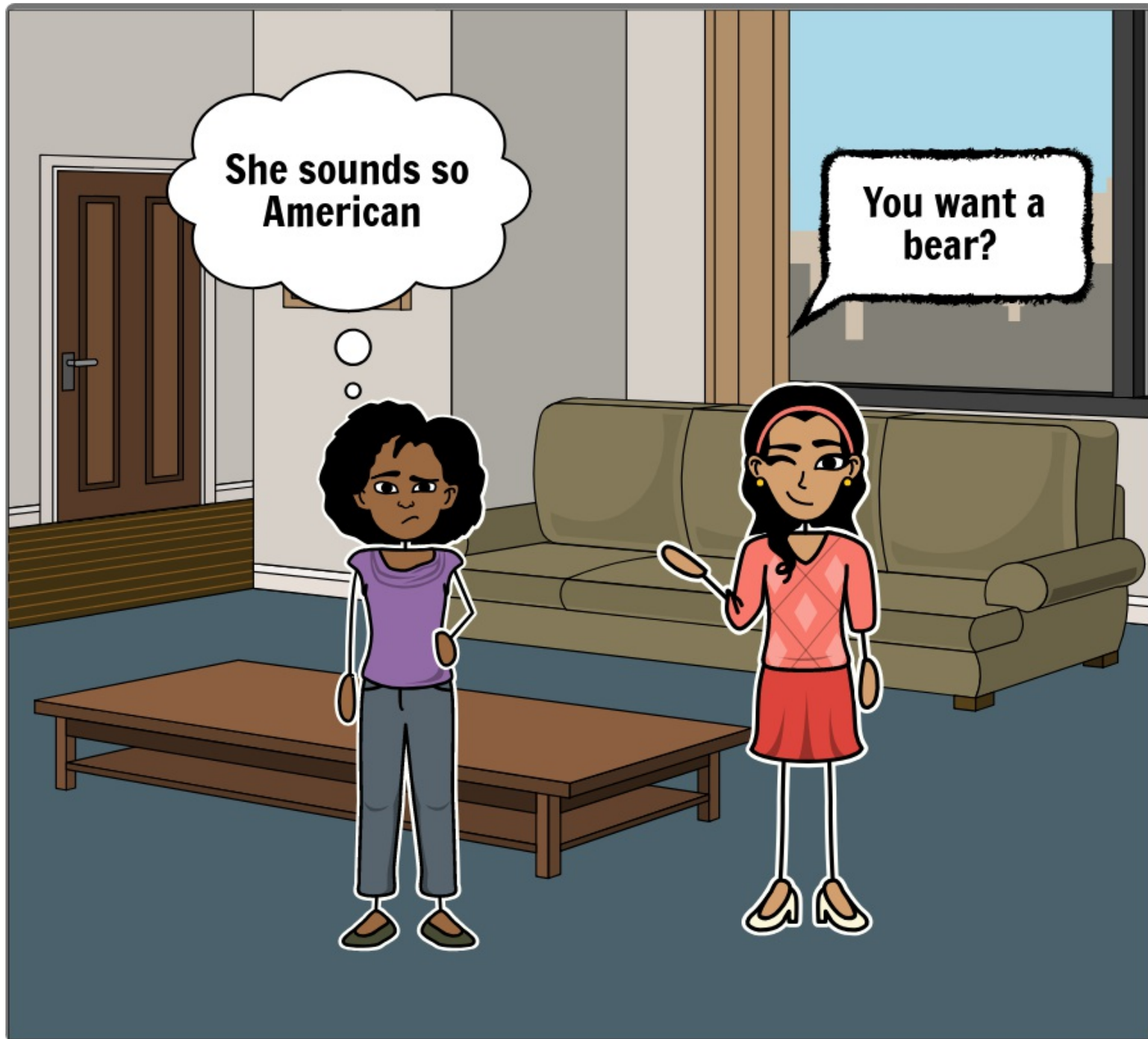
